
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


#### Seminar on IPR - As a Strategic Tool in India'

# REPORT OF THE TRAINING SESSIONS ON PROFESSIONAL SKILLS 10<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2020 to 7<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2020 ORGANISED BY THAKUR RAMNARAYAN COLLEGE OF LAW

#### BACKGROUND

- Reason/Objective- The Placement Committee organised the Training Sessions on Professional Skills with the objective of improving the diverse set of professional skills of the students of Thakur Ramnarayan College of Law, Mumbai who are participating in the placement process.

The above-mentioned sessions were held for a period of 3 (three) hours, commencing from 12 noon until 3:00 pm and was attended to by the placement cell students of TRCL along with the faculty. The last 2 (two) sessions, however, convened on 29 February 2020 and 7 March 2020 respectively were held between 10:45 AM – 01:45 PM.

# FIRST SESSION ON BRAINSTORMING
