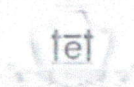

- Vehicles will not be permitted without seeking prior permission.

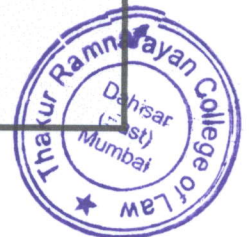
