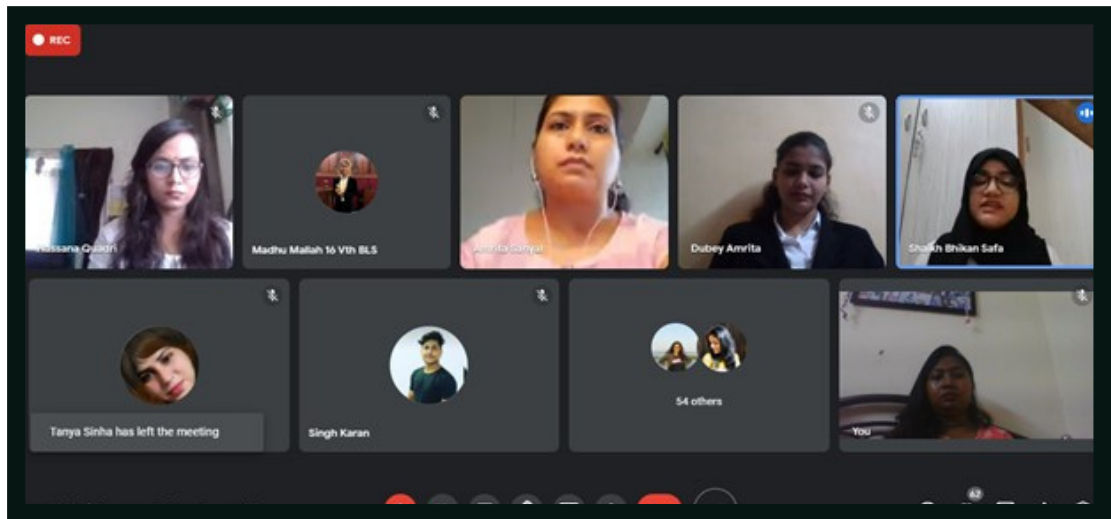
EXTRA CURRICULAR & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

During the Academic Year 2020-21, we also continued with extra-curricular and co-curricular activities. A snapshot of the same is presented below:

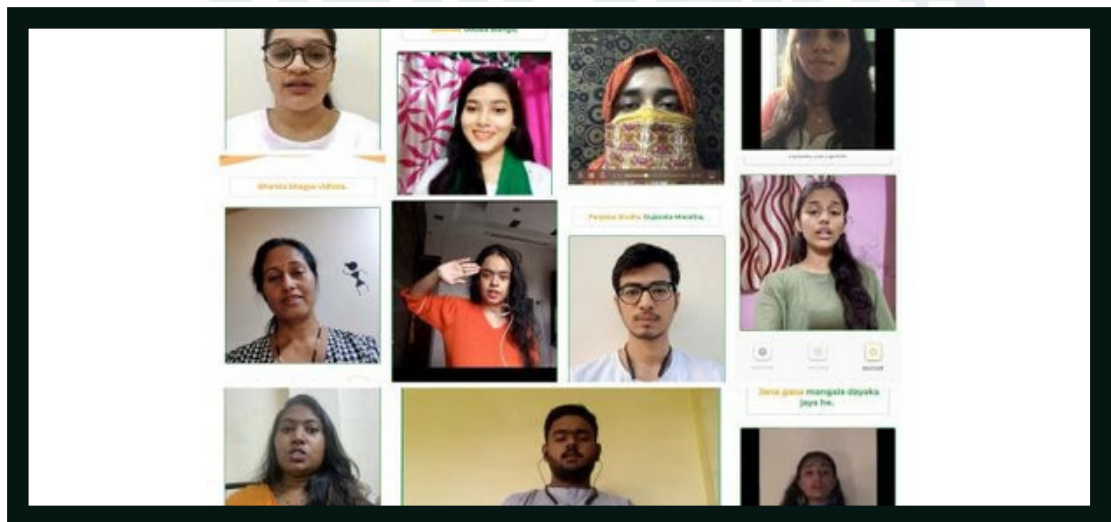

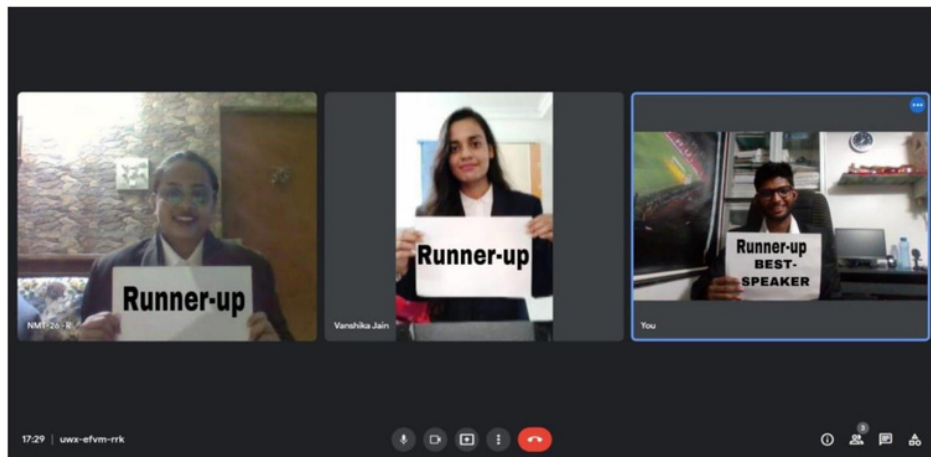

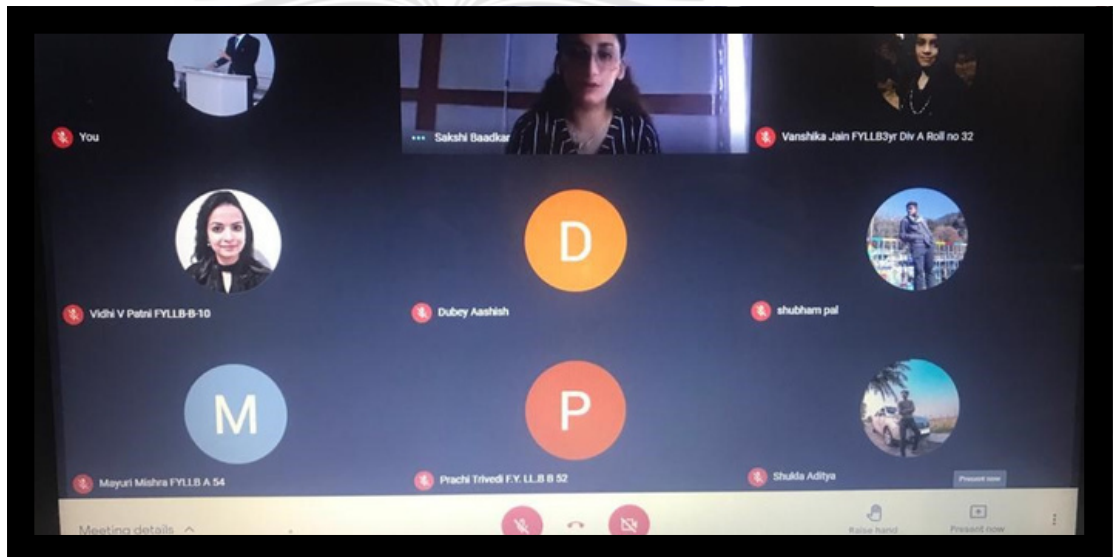
MOOT COURT ACHIEVEMENTS



MOOT COURT TRAINING

- MCA started a new platform to train every law student and teams for National and International Competitions, which takes place every 2nd Week of the month. Several eminent mooters and advocates from the High Courts and the Supreme Court are invited to mentor our students.
- Boot camp on trial advocacy was conducted by Mr. Abhishek Singh and Ms. Sakshi Baadkar for the students to make them familiar with various aspects of trial advocacy. Total pf 20 students attended the camp.
- MCA provides a platform for every law student, who wants to participate in National/International Moot by providing Internal Selection platform. 8 Internal Selection has been conducted out of which 14 teams made it National and International Moots.
- MCA organized the 1st Fresher's Moot Court Competition for the 1st year of B.L.S/LL.B. and 1st year of LL.B. from 3rd - 4th July.
- MCA organized their 1st Intra trial advocacy competition for B.L.S/LL.B. students from 26th - 28th June. 20 teams participated for this competition.

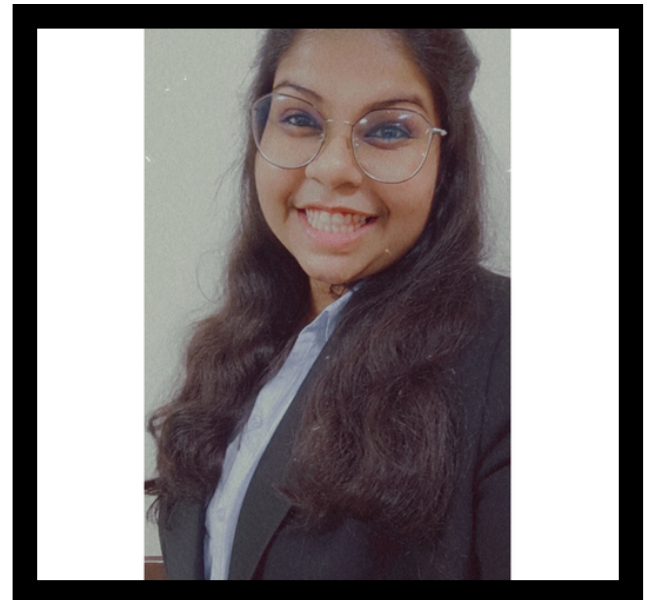

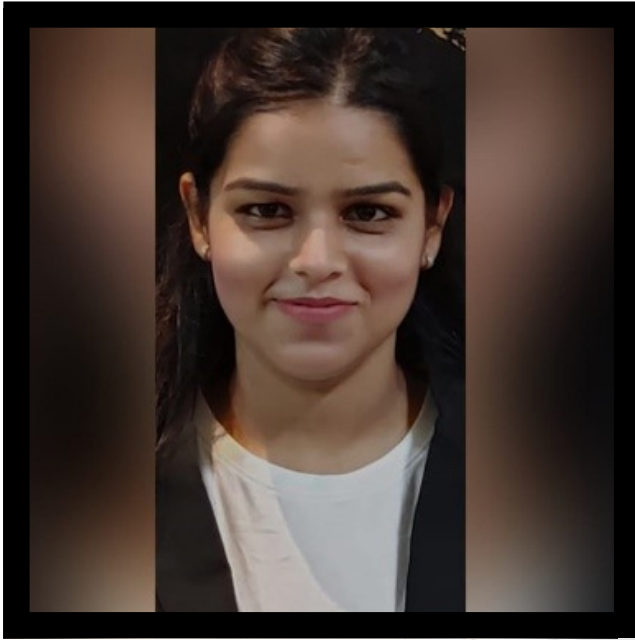

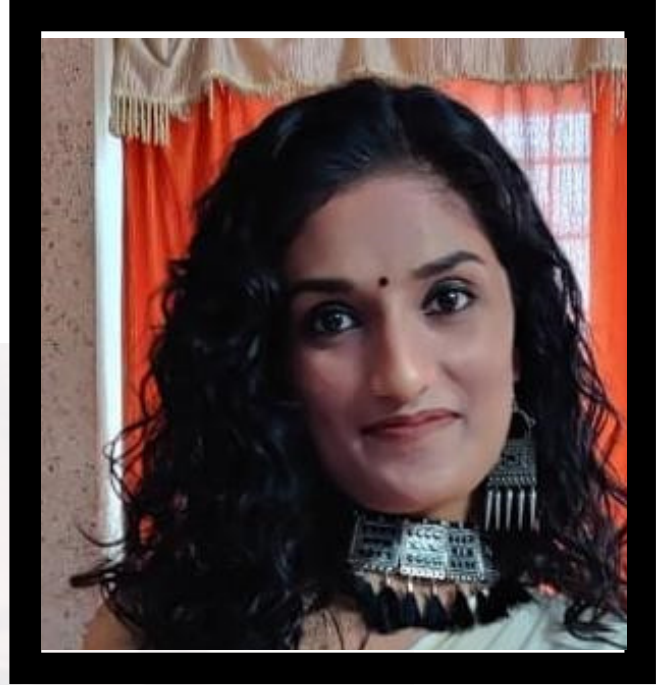
