

GREEN CAMPUS POLICY

STATEMENT:

Thakur Ramnarayan College of Law aims to create a responsible campus community. Through the implementation of the Green Campus Policy, we aim to reduce our carbon footprint, conserve resources and simultaneously promote environmental awareness among students, faculty, and staff.

POLICY OBJECTIVES:

- Promoting and exploring opportunities for energy-efficient technologies and practices in college to minimise energy consumption.
- Implement comprehensive waste reduction strategies, including recycling programs and waste diversion initiatives and encouraging the use of reusable materials and promote responsible consumption habits among the campus community.
- Promote public transit to reduce reliance on single-occupancy vehicles.
- Integrate sustainability and environmental literacy into the curriculum across disciplines. Organise educational programs, and events to raise awareness about environmental issues and empower the campus community to take action.

THE CAMPUS POLICY

1. **Restrictions on Entry of Vehicles:** Only Faculty Members and Staff are allowed to bring and park their private vehicles on the campus.
2. **Ban on use of Plastic:** The college aims to become a plastic-free campus. To this effect, it also promotes elimination of single-use plastics.
3. **Pedestrians-friendly Campus:** The pathways created in the Campus are pedestrian-friendly.
4. **Landscaping with Greenery:** Trees and other plants must be planted to create a clean environment.

5. **Efficient Resources Management:** In order to reduce energy consumption, TRCL promotes the usage of power-efficient air conditioners, LED lights, etc.
6. **Waste Management:** The three Rs of Sustainability must be adopted. To this effect, practices such as segregation, recycling and reduction of waste must be promoted.
7. **Conservation Practices:** Solar panels have been installed and rainwater harvesting has been set up to conserve resources. The Institution promotes practices such as turning off lights and other electrical appliances when not in use, closing water taps properly, etc. Concession is to be provided for using public mode of transportation.
8. **Outreach Education:** Through co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, awareness about environmental issues and empowerment to take action must be undertaken.
9. **Observation of Policy:** All stakeholders must adhere to the Policy Guidelines and actively support its objectives.
